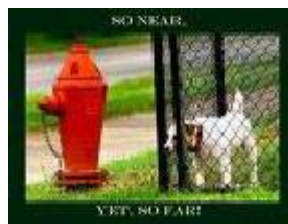

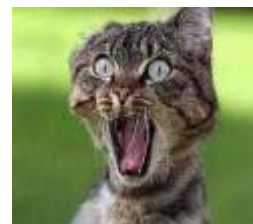

I will be watching this summer.

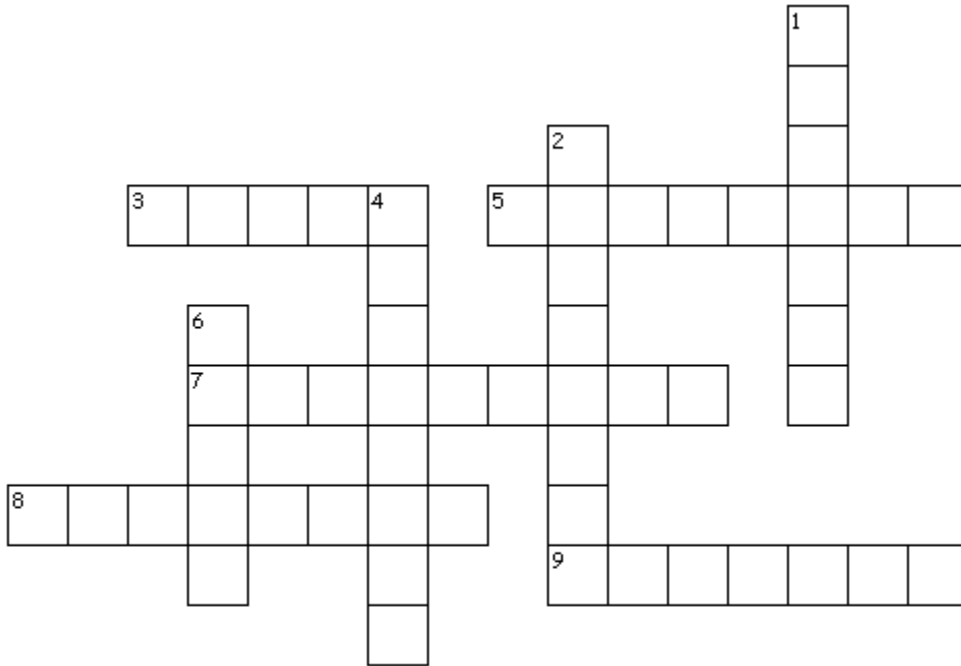
