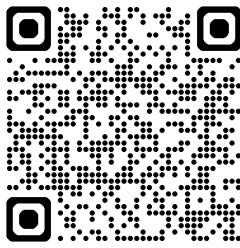

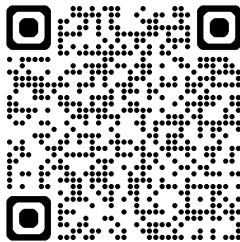


What is an Individualized Education Program (IEP) for Families of Preschool Students

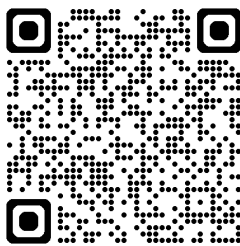
Early Intervention (EI) to CPSE (Committee on Preschool Special Education for Parents

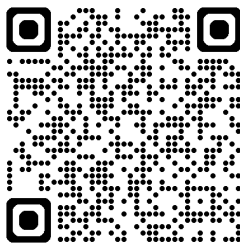

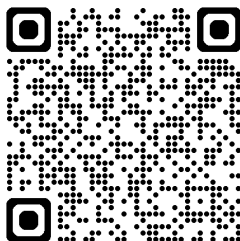


Agency 101: An Overview of Services to Support Students with Disabilities into Adulthood

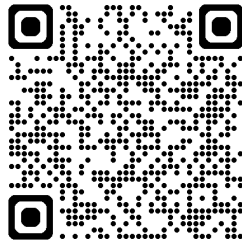


How to Foster and Support Self-Determination in All Students
