

FILING YOUR FAFSA CHECKLIST:



- 2013 Federal and State tax return copies for parent(s) and student
- 2013 w-2's for parent(s) and student
- Student license #
- Parent('s) you are living with and student name, social security number and dates of birth
- If anyone in the household received any of these benefits:
 - Supplemental security income
 - Food stamps
 - Free or reduced price school lunch
 - TANF
 - WIC
- Amount of 2013 Child Support PAID (if any)
- Amount of 2013 Child Support RECEIVED (if any)
- Amount of 2013 Combat Pay received (if any)
- Amount of 2013 Tax Exempt Interest Income (if any)
- Amount of 2013 untaxed pensions or IRA distributions or Worker's compensation received
- Amount currently in cash and savings/checking accounts
- Current value of investments, such as stocks or bonds
- Value and debt (if any) of any property that is not their primary residence.
- Value and debt (if any) of any business that is owned by parent (or student)

Federal PIN #

(This will be your electronic signature for Federal Education Department)

A parent and the student will need a federal PIN number. Go to pin.ed.gov and apply for a PIN number.
